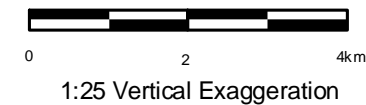
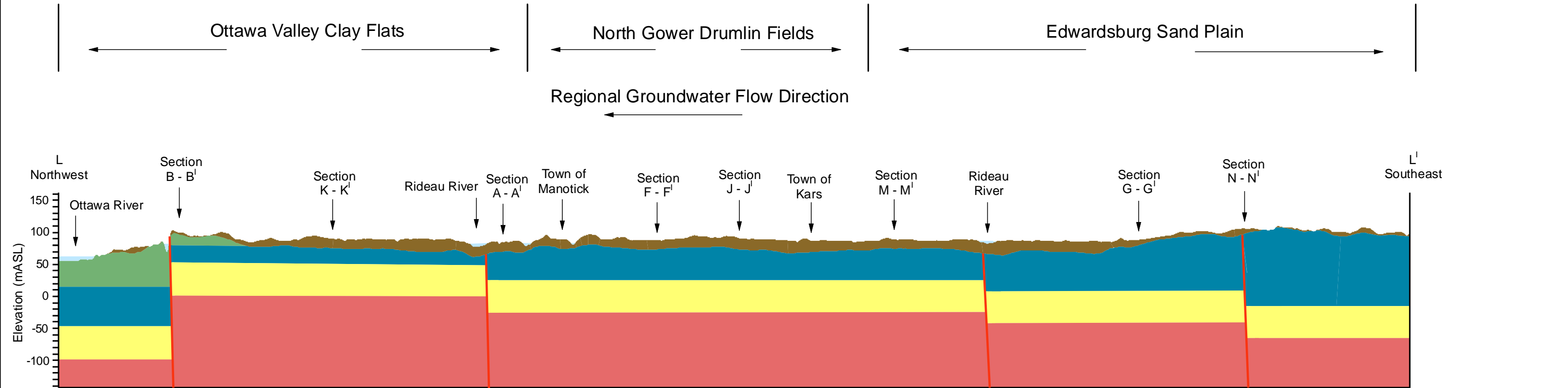
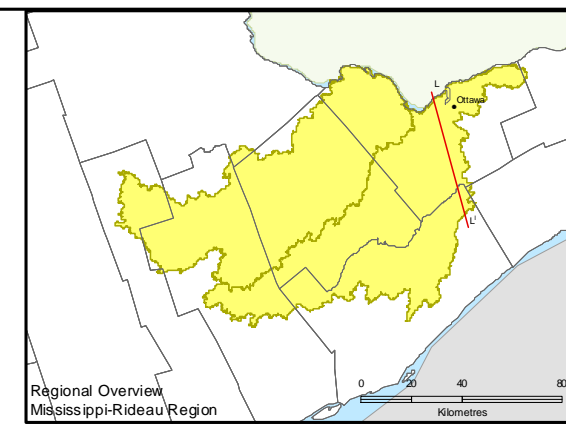


Mississippi-Rideau Source Protection Region
